

THE CHARTER OF THE BOLE DISTRICT ASSEMBLY

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This Bole District Charter sets out the broad legal framework in respect of the provision of public services to communities at the District Level as enshrined in the Local Government Act, 2016 Act 936.

The Client Service Unit's Charter outlines the vision, mission objectives, structure, authority and responsibilities of Management, as well as other departments, units, sub-structures and communities in the District Assembly.

1.2 Vision

To become a transparent and accountable decentralized institution.

1.3 Purpose and Mission

The purpose of the District Assembly is to contribute to the development of governance by improving transparency, internal accountability and public service delivery at the district level.

The mission of the Bole District Assembly is to improve the living standard of the people in the district through effective co-ordination of resources to promote the needed quality services

Objectives of the Organization

- a) To be responsible for the overall development of the district
- b) To formulate and execute plans, programmes and strategies for the effective mobilization of resources necessary for the overall development of the district.
- c) To promote and support productive activities and social development in the district.
- d) To initiate programmes for the development of basic infrastructure and provide works and services in the district.
- e) To be responsible for the development, improvement and management of human settlement and the environment in the district.

1.4 Authority

The District Assembly is headed by the District Chief Executive who is the Political Head of the District. Whiles the District Co-ordinating Director is the Administrative Head, empowered to co-ordinate all departments and units of the Assembly for effective and efficient resource utilization for the development of the district.

1.5 Conflicts and Disputes

Notwithstanding any conflict resolution mechanism of the Bole District Assembly, this Charter shall form the basis for the authority and actions of the Assembly as far as the performance of the roles and responsibilities of the District Assembly are concerned. Any irresolvable conflict or disputes which arise during the course of performing its function which, in the opinion of the District Assembly, would present a significant limitation in scope shall be brought to the attention of the District Security Committee (DISEC)


1.6 Affirmation, Effectiveness, and Amendment
